

### **KEYNOTE SPEAKERS**



George M. Abraham, MD, MPH, MACP, FIDSA, FRCP, FEFIM

Dr. George M. Abraham, professor of medicine at the University of Massachusetts Medical School and chief of

medicine at Saint Vincent Hospital, Worcester, Mass., will share insights as former president of the American College of Physicians (ACP) and his current role as chair-elect of the Board of Directors of the Federation of State Medical Boards.

The weekend's second guest presenter will be Dr. Susan V. George who will offer the lecture, "The Evolution of Learning and Teaching
